Indonesia's Remarkable Cocoa

Chocolate. Chocolate transforming from Cacao beans. Cacao is not a native plant of Indonesia. It is not even an Asian native plant. Cacao is an American plant. The Dutch introduced the cacao to the archipelago in 1560. The first cocoa seed from Caracas Venezuela was taken to the Indonesian island of Sulawesi (Celebes). Today Indonesia stands as one of the major producers of cacao beans.

There were 4,359 million Ton of cocoa beans produced in the 2014 in world. *Indonesia* is the world's third-largest producer of cocoa beans with 454 thousand tonnes production of cacao after *Cote d'Ivore* and *Ghana*.
