

Biscuit is a term used for a diverse variety of baked, commonly flour-based food products. The term is applied to two distinct products in North America and the Commonwealth of Nations and Europe. The North American biscuit is typically a soft, leavened quick bread, and is covered in the article Biscuit (bread). This article covers the other type of biscuit, which is typically hard, flat and unleavened.

In gastronomy, a **wafer** is a crisp, often sweet, very thin, flat, and dry biscuit, often used to decorate ice cream. Wafers can also be made into cookies with cream flavoring sandwiched between them. They frequently have a waffle surface pattern but may also be patterned with insignia of the food's manufacturer or may be pattern less. Many chocolate bars, such as Kit Kat and Coffee Crisp, have wafers in them.

There were products - snack food products from Indonesia such as biscuits and wafers that have HS code 1905 (Bread, pastry cake etc) to compete in the global market. Even some of which have become an export commodity remain in various countries.

Total world export for such products valued to US\$ 29 billion in 2015. Which the highest country is Germany amounted to 3.4 billion and the runner up country is Canada which also contributed US\$ 2 billion in same years. While Indonesia ranked 16 and Korea, Rep of ranked 25.
